The Berkeley League of Women voters has prepared a composite chart indicating the vot ing records of Borkeley city coincilmen as they, relate to key, substantive issues over the fore-going two-year period.

League spokesmen said citizens should be aware the composite chart reproduced here does not represent a 100 per cent voting record. It is rather a selected city council vote to

provide a profile of council action.

The League excluded purely procedural votes and tried only to include the votes which substantively reflect a councilman's position.
