It's illegal

It's costing the Berkeley Post Office a minimum of \$68 a day to scrape off and

repaint sidewalk mailboxes which are being plastered with campaign posters — most of them touting the April Coalition.

with Coalition posters on three sides of the mailboxes. THE POSTMASTER said there is almost complete saturation throughout the south campus area, but some also have cropped up between Sacramento Street and Shattuck Avenue and Dwight Way to University Avenue.

Postmaster William Wollman said he's had a crew of two men out every day for three weeks assigned to that one task.

This defacing, he said, is not peculiar to Berkeley, although it is worse here than any other city of which he is aware.

Normally, Wollman said, the boxes are painted every three years, one third of them each year.

Wollman said his cleanup crew has worked on approximately 75 boxes and has approximately 75 more to go.

HE SAID HE has notified postal inspectors of the problem as the posting of anything, particularly political signs, on federal property violates federal law.

Nixon aide predicts boycott 'disaster'
