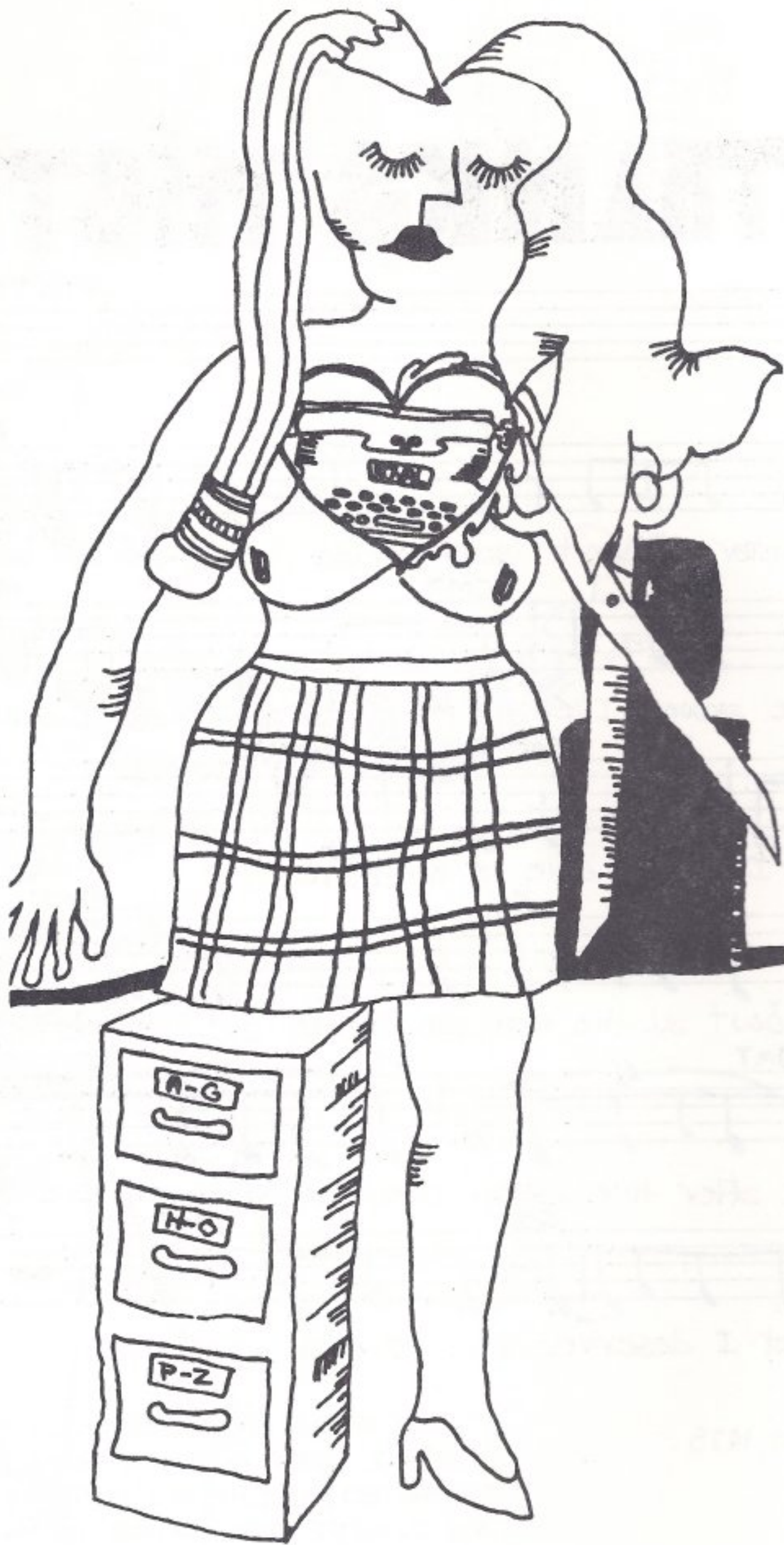
I've got a friend she works in a bank in San Francisco

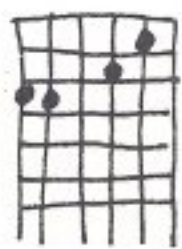
AT THE DAY'S END (3)

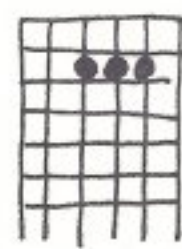
